Course to certify Liquid Petroleum Gas (LPG) competent persons

The Malta Resources Authority will be holding a course to certify competent persons to carry out assessments, supervise alterations and certify authorised (LPG) facilities.

The course is open for persons who hold a warrant to practice the profession of an engineer under the Engineering Profession Act or the equivalent professional qualification as provided under the Mutual Recognition of Qualifications Act. Interested applicants should also have suitable training, sufficient knowledge, experience and skill in gas technology. The course, which will be held at MCAST in Naxxar, will be delivered in partnership with the European Registration Scheme for Personnel Competence (ERS) as the accrediting institution and MNPLG Consultancy as tutors. The full time course will be held between the 8th and the 15th of March 2010, including Saturday 13th March 2010. A similar course is also planned to be held between the 19th and the 26th of April 2010.

Registration fee for the course is €1,100 including all course material, the use of the laboratory and examination fees. Registration forms may be downloaded from the MRA website www.mra.org.mt. A maximum of 12 participants will accepted for each course and applications will be accepted on a first come first served basis. All applications should be received by 20th February 2010. Late applications will not be considered.

Successful candidates will be issued with certificates from the European Registration Scheme for Personnel Competence.
