***PUBLIC CONSULTATION - Draft Authorisation (Suspension, Refusal and Revocation) Regulations***

The Malta Resources Authority will be proposing to Government the publication of Regulations that will set parameters which the Authority has to take into account when it is considering applications for authorisations (or changes thereto) by applicants who have been convicted of certain offences, or against whom criminal proceedings are sub-judice.

Stakeholders, interested parties and the general public, are being invited to comment on these draft regulations and also on other matters they consider relevant to the issue.
