Certification of Engineers

The Malta Resources Authority is compiling a register of engineers with qualification in LPG technologies desirous of being approved as 'competent persons' as described in the Liquid Petroleum Gas Regulations, Legal Notice 249 of 2008. It is receiving applications from persons holding a warrant to practice the profession of an engineer interested in being so registered.

Legal Notice 249 of 2008 establishes that a competent person is authorised to carry out assessment inspections, supervise material alterations and certify authorised facilities including fixed pipe networks, secondary storage facilities of LPG and autogas retail stations according to guidelines and Codes of Practice approved by the MRA.

Those interested in being qualified as a 'competent person', should apply on the form provided on the website www.mra.org.mt or that can be picked up from the offices of the Authority. Together with the application, applicants are to submit a detailed CV clearly indicating all relevant training, knowledge, experience and skill in LPG technology.

Most importantly applicants are to include a copy of the:

1. Engineering warrant; and
2. Certificates of competence clearly indicating the modules relating to LPG storage vessels and LPG piping.

Approval shall be granted if the Authority is satisfied that the person requesting such approval satisfies the requirements established in the legal notice.

The MRA would also like to advise that in the coming months it shall be organising a course so that engineers interested in the area and not having the appropriate certification would sit for assessments and later, if successful, be approved as a 'competent person' in terms of LN 249 of 2008.
