**Tender for Supply and Delivery of Low Emission Vehicles  
for the Malta Resources Authority**

**Clarification Note 4:**

- 1. Kindly confirm if the vehicles requested in LOT 1 & LOT 2 pay registration tax, that is length and CO<sub>2</sub> tax?**

Yes. Reference should also be made to Clarification Note 3 – response to question 2.

- 2. Under Tender documentation, paragraph 1.13 page five, there is mentioned as follow:**

***“Tenderer’s shall submit with their offer CERTIFICATES/LOGBOOKS/ INSURANCES/PERMITS etc. Failure to comply with this clause shall render the Tender offer null.”***

***Please advise what is exactly meant by:***

- (i) Certificates?***
- (ii) Log-book: Is this the logbook issued by ADT? And if yes does this mean that the total price shall include road expenses.***
- (iii) Insurance: Would you like total price to include road insurance cover per vehicle?***
- (iv) Permits: Please advise what is meant by permits.***

This is a general clause issued in departmental tenders. In this particular tender, it is further clarified that with respect to the abovementioned documents:

- (i) Certificates – shall include the technical data sheets referred to in section 8.3.1;**
- (ii) Logbook –No vehicle logbooks issued by Transport Malta are required to be submitted at tendering stage.**
- (iii) Insurance - No. Road insurance is a separate item which shall be paid for by MRA independently of the tender**
- (iv) Permits – No permits are required to be submitted by tenderers with their tender offer.**
