**Tender for the provision of legal services to the Malta Resources Authority**

**Question 1:**

“Kindly clarify what documentation is required attesting experience in the litigation cases related to regulatory work, as well as what evidence is required to show that the bidder has handled a minimum of 10 administrative law cases in the relevant area of work. Both requirements are indicated under point 1.2.11 as well as 8.4 of the tender document.”

**Reply:**

Reference is made to Section 1.2.11 and to Section 8.4 specifically Section 8.4.1 (iv), (v) and (vi) of the tender document relating to documentation which is required attesting experience in litigation cases related to regulatory work, as well as to evidence which is required to show that the bidder has handled a minimum of 10 administrative law cases in the relevant area of work. It is clarified that:

1. Ten (10) copies of judicial acts signed by the bidder who is the holder of a warrant of advocate are required as evidence to show that the bidder has handled a minimum of 10 administrative law cases in the relevant area of work.
2. Ten (10) copies of minutes of court sittings (*verbali*) spanning a two year period are required showing 2 years litigation experience in the Maltese Courts of Justice.

**Question 2:**

“Moreover, point 8.5.2 refers to a document named 'Professional Staff Overview'. This document is not annexed to the Tender Document, kindly indicate from where a bidder may obtain a copy of this document.”

**Reply:**
